

## White Wines

- Ladera Verde Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile** £14.95  
Crisp and fresh with limey fruit, a hint of herbs and a twist of melon.  
125ml Glass £2.70      250ml Glass £5.10
- Los Vilos Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile** £14.95  
Chardonnay and a dash of Sauvignon Blanc blend well to give aromas of tropical fruit.

- Freedom Cross Chenin Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa** £15.95  
Full, ripe apple fruit mingles with tropical flavours leading to a clean, dry finish.
- Pleno Viura, Navarra, Spain** £15.95  
Fresh and crisp dry white with hints of tropical fruit, smooth and well balanced.
- La Cabane Blanc VdP du Comté Tolosan, France** £16.95  
A fresh and aromatic white with juicy fruit,
- Piesporter Michelsberg QbA, Moselland, Germany** £16.95  
From the very well run co-operative at Bernkastel, this is a deliciously fruity wine that has a clean, grapey character and a refreshing off-dry sweetness. Well-made, it is a great for any occasion.
- Amanti del Vino, Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie IGT, Italy** £16.95  
Crisp, refreshing and unoaked, making it perfect for drinking before or during any meal.
- Terra de Lobos Fernão Pires/Sauvignon Blanc, Casal Branco, Portugal** £17.95  
A lovey spicy hint of Muscat or Gewürztraminer on the nose followed by ripe apricot fruit on the palate.
- Sunnycliff Chardonnay, Victoria, Australia** £18.95  
Mildura in northern Victoria is the perfect place for vines, with water from the Murray and sunshine in abundance. This wine has sheer drinkability, everything is well balanced so one glass is not enough!
- Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine des Lauriers, Coteaux du Languedoc, France** £19.95  
Imagine the most perfect steely dry, mineral white with a slight spritz, and there you have it, Picpoul!
- Grüner Veltliner Wachau Collection, Domäne Wachau, Austria** £19.95  
A fresh, mouthwatering Grüner with flavours of green apples, spice a touch of white pepper and honey on the finish.
- C J Pask Sauvignon Blanc, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand** £21.95  
A typical New Zealand Sauvignon with opulent, ripe, tropical fruit and all the classic Sauvignon character one could wish for.
- Mâcon-Vergisson, La Roche, France** £23.95  
A delightfully mineral, 'bready', Chablis-style Mâcon. It's a great fish or shellfish wine .
- Villa Antinori Bianco, Toscana IGT, Antinori, Italy** £26.95  
An accomplished dry white that is floral then soft and fresh in the mouth.
- McHenry Hohnen Sauvignon/Semillon, Margaret River, Australia** £27.95  
Fruity, juicy and pure with good body and a crisp freshness.
- Chablis, Pascal Bouchard, France** £28.95  
A classic Chablis with freshness, minerality and good weight from an excellent producer.
- Pouilly-Fumé, Jean Pabiot, France** £31.00  
A wine with excellent fruit and classic flintiness from some of the best vineyards in Pouilly.
- Montagny 1er cru, 'Les Loges', vieilles vignes, Caves de Buxy, France** £33.00  
This cuvée is oak-aged, but the wood is in harmony with the fruit.

## Red Wines

- Ladera Verde Merlot, Central Valley, Chile** £14.95  
This has lovely plummy Merlot fruit with a ripeness that is so typical of Chile.

- Los Vilos Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile** £14.95  
The classic combination of Cabernet Sauvignon and a dash of Merlot makes this a fruity, soft and flavoursome red.

- Pampas Shiraz/Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** £15.95  
Full, meaty wine with spicy plum fruit and soft tannins providing structure.
- Pleno Tempranillo, Navarra, Spain** £15.95  
Attractive and fruity red with crunchy, leafy blackcurrant and strawberry fruit flavours. Fresh, lively and very well made.
- La Cabane Rouge, VdP de l'Hérault, France** £16.95  
This is a soft and easy going red from Carignan, Grenache and Merlot grapes grown in the historic Hérault countryside. It is full of ripe, spicy fruit.
- Alto Pampas Pinot Noir, Mendoza, Argentina** £16.95  
The grapes are grown in higher altitude vineyards to keep freshness, so the wine shows fine, very pure New World Pinot fruit with typical leafy, raspberry flavours and soft, ripe tannins.
- Terra de Lobos Castelão/Cabernet Sauvignon, Casal Branco, Portugal** £17.95  
Full of lovely crunchy fruit with floral hints on the nose, the palate is weighty with rich red and black fruit character.
- Rayun Carmenère, Central Valley, Chile** £17.95  
It has taken a while, but Chilean winemakers now understand this old Bordeaux grape variety: late picking and slightly cooler slopes are key, and the result is a rich, curranty wine with depth and length.
- Rioja Vega Tempranillo, Black Label, Spain** £17.95  
A soft, fruity wine with plum and blackcurrant flavours, vibrant and juicy. This is a young (joven) wine without any oak, made to be drunk in its youth to appreciate its lively fruit. From a forward looking winery that has invested a lot of money in recent years.
- Slowine Shiraz, Overberg, South Africa** £18.95  
Very good, chocolaty wine which is soft and easy, but with a nice bite on the end. The Common Padloper tortoise on the label is found locally.
- Côtes du Rhône, Les Grandes Serres, France** £19.95  
This is a good, simple Côtes du Rhône: it has typical peppery flavours and light, fresh fruit that goes well with red meat and game.
- Chianti Colli Senesi DCGG, Geografico, Italy** £20.95  
Medium body and mild tannins make it all too easy to drink.
- Trentham Estate Pinot Noir, New South Wales, Australia** £22.95  
A well-structured number, full of red berry fruit, toasty oak and a soft, lingering finish.
- Wente Beyer Ranch Zinfandel, San Francisco Bay, California, USA** £23.95  
Classically fruity Zinfandel with aromas of plums with hints of raspberry and blueberry. It is well-balanced on the palate with good acidity.
- Fleurie, Domaine de la Viroylette, J Charlet, France** £25.95  
Attractive, wild strawberry fruit is abundant in this wine making it a particularly juicy and good value example.
- Saint-Emilion, Jean-Pierre Moueix, France** £29.95  
Libourne-based négociants J-P Moueix are specialists in the wines of that region and their Saint-Emilion is one of the very best available.
- Condado de Haza, Ribera del Duero, Alejandro Fernández, Spain** £32.95  
Bottled after 15 months in oak, this is a concentrated wine with spicy fruit and a long, lingering finish.
- Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Télégramme, H Brunier et Fils, France** £36.95  
Lovely soft fruit with spice, plums, herbs and a touch of leather behind. Quite forward in the mouth with soft, ripe tannins, great length and a luscious finish.

## Rosé Wines

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- 37. Pleno Garnacha Rosado, Navarra, Spain** £14.95  
Easy going rosé with attractive strawberry fruit, juicy and fresh, from a modern bodega in the Navarra region of Spain.

- 38. Pato Torrente Merlot Rosé, Central Valley, Chile** £15.95  
This is an off-dry, fruity rosé, with plenty of strawberry flavours and lively, refreshing acidity.
- 39. Pinot Grigio Rosé, Provincia di Pavia IGT, Ca' Solare, Italy** £17.50  
Gently fragrant summer fruits on the nose and delicate strawberry fruit on the palate. Fruitily off-dry.

## Sparkling Wines and Champagnes

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- 40. Prosecco, Vetriciano, Italy** £19.95  
This is very similar instyle to a Cava or Champagne and has none of the fruit juice character of inferior producers. A yeasty nose followed by a biscuity palate, great chilled.
- 41. Baron de Beaupre Brut, France** £34.95  
A good characterful Champagne with fine mousse, full fruity flavour and a toasty finish. Great value for money!
- 42. Michel Arnould Brut Rosé, France** £38.95  
A gorgeous, rich rosé colour with typical Pinot fruit on the nose, wonderfully fresh with notes of red-berried fruit and cherries. The mousse is fine with lovely richness and well- balanced acidity. An excellent, full-flavoured rosé.
- 43. Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label, France** £49.95  
The full flavour of this champagne comes from good maturation. Soft, baked bread and biscuity nose, with creamy white fruits and a long lasting flavour. Stylish, elegant and full-bodied.
- 44. Bollinger Grande Année Brut, Vintage 2000, France** £89.00  
Intense, rich and complex with notes of butter, caramel and toffee. Aged for a minimum of five years on its lees, and under cork, before its release, this excellent bone-dry champagne is full and ripe with fine texture and mousse.

## Dessert Wine

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- 45. Château Le Fagé Monbazillac, France - Half** £16.50  
This is a luscious dessert wine, brimming with ripe botrytised fruit, both complex and intense. François Gerardin and son, Benoit, cultivate 40 hectares of rolling vineyard near Bergerac.
